Ratios, percentages, finding increase/decrease percentage, discounts, profit and loss, and simple and compound interest, all with real-world applications.

Comparing Quantities" chapter aims to equip students with the ability to understand and apply concepts like ratios, percentages, profit/loss, sales tax, GST, and simple/compound interest, enabling them to solve realworld financial problems.
