Report on Solid Steps Mobile App Installation and Resource Kit Induction

📅 Date: 5th July 2025 (Saturday)

Objective: To orient teachers with the Solid Steps mobile application and equip them with the necessary tools and understanding to effectively deliver the curriculum using the provided resource kit.

Key Discussions and Resolutions:

Session Demonstration:

A brief recap of the curriculum content was conducted through a live demonstration by the resource person, showcasing effective classroom delivery techniques.

Guidance by Moni Ma'am:

Moni Ma'am provided insightful guidance on using appropriate keywords during content delivery to ensure clarity and learning reinforcement for students. She also shared strategies for classroom management, including how to handle different student behaviors with patience and consistency.

Additionally, Moni Ma'am visited classrooms to observe live teaching and offered constructive feedback based on real-time situations. Her classroom observations helped teachers better understand how to apply theoretical knowledge in practical settings.

Teacher Manual Overview: A concise explanation of the Teacher Manual (Part A) was provided. Hard copies were distributed to all attending teachers for easy reference and lesson planning.

Mobile App Installation: The Solid Steps mobile app was successfully installed on each teacher's Smartphone. Unique login credentials were created and shared securely.

App Walkthrough:

Teachers were guided through the app's features including access to book pages, the digital Teacher Manual, printable worksheets, and multimedia content to enhance learning outcomes.

Student Progress Card Introduction:

Both digital (in-app) and hard copy formats of the Student Progress Card were introduced and explained, enabling teachers to effectively monitor and record student performance.

Resource Kit Demonstration:

Hands-on training was conducted to demonstrate the effective use of the Resource Kit in the classroom. Components such as hand puppets, beats, flashcards, 3D shapes, and blocks were explained with activity examples. Kits were distributed class-wise.

Query Resolution:

An interactive Q&A session allowed teachers to raise questions. All queries were addressed and resolved efficiently by the trainer and Moni Ma'am.

Feedback Collection:

Teachers submitted their reflections and suggestions through a Google Form circulated at the end of the session.



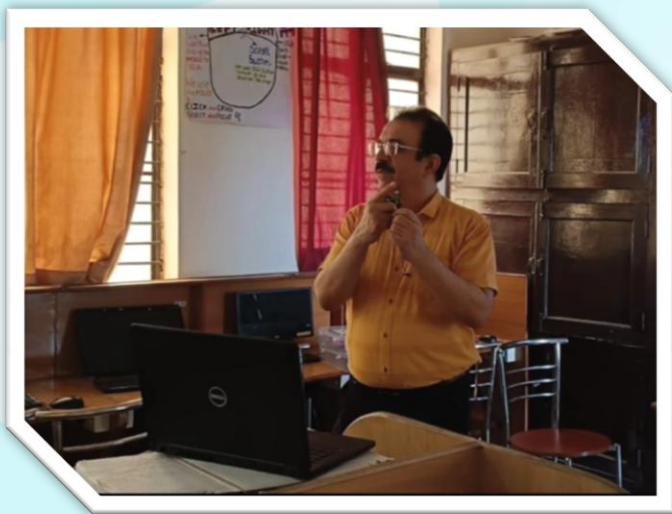

Teacher Training Workshop

(Date: 19 July 2025)

To promote digital learning and practical knowledge, Professor's Global School organised a Teacher Training Workshop on 19 July 2025, focused on Basic Coding, Sensors, and IoT Concepts. The session was conducted in collaboration with Sushil Chawla, Brainwave Publications.



Workshop Highlights:

Introduction to Sensors:

Ultrasonic Sensor – For distance measurement and object detection.

IR Sensor (Infrared Sensor) – For obstacle detection.

Smoke Sensor – For detecting smoke in fire safety systems.

Temperature Sensor – To measure temperature.

Humidity Sensor – To measure moisture levels in the air.

Fire Sensor (Flame Sensor) – For detecting flames.

Sound/Voice Sensor – To detect sounds or claps.

Basic Coding Concepts:

Introduction to Block Coding using PictoBlox.

Demonstrated how to control traffic lights (red, yellow, green) using digital pins.

Explained connecting devices using USB cables, ESP32 boards, with a basic understanding of Bluetooth/Wi-Fi connectivity.

IoT Activities:

- Automatic device control using mobile apps and sensors.
- Detecting surroundings and controlling devices digitally.
- Live demonstration of turning devices ON/OFF through coding.

STEAM Learning Approach:

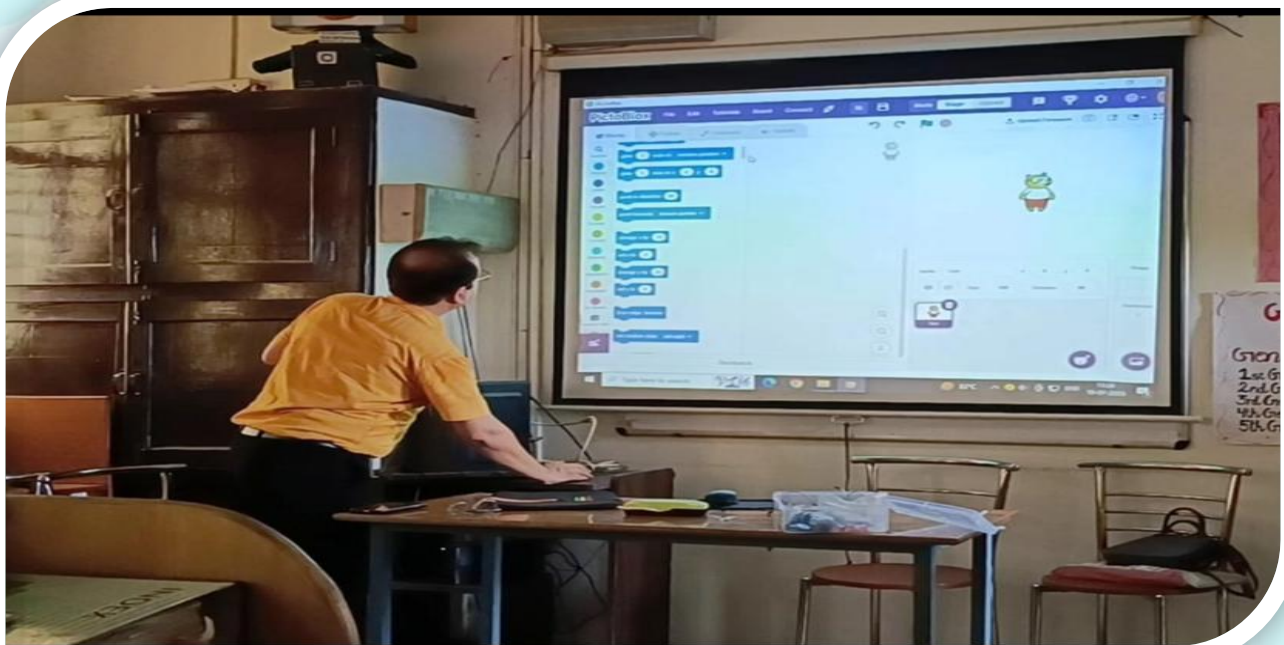
- Focus on the Playway Method for engaging learning.
- Encouraged teachers to integrate basic science activities with creative art materials (cups, sticks etc.).

Workshop Objective:

To empower teachers with basic knowledge of coding, sensors, and IoT concepts, encouraging them to integrate simple technological activities in classrooms to enhance students' practical understanding.

Outcome:

The session was informative and interactive. Teachers gained confidence in using basic technology tools and understanding sensors, ready to incorporate them in classroom teaching.
