



The visit to Publication House proved to be highly educational and inspiring, as it not only enhanced the students' knowledge of the publishing industry but also deepened their appreciation for books.















The celebration was a perfect blend of tradition, devotion, cultural vibrancy, and ecoconsciousness, leaving a lasting impression on everyone present.






















This month we face our mid-term test, With books in hand, we give our best.
