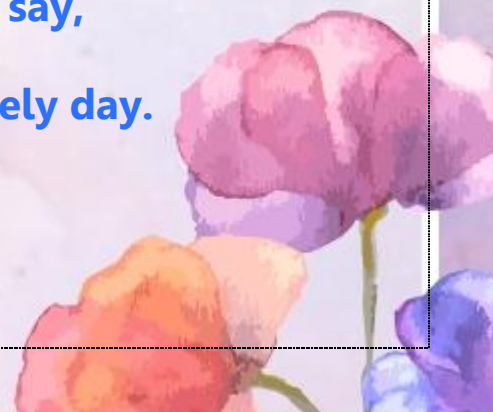

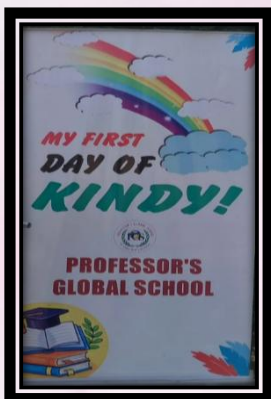


HAVAN CEREMONY

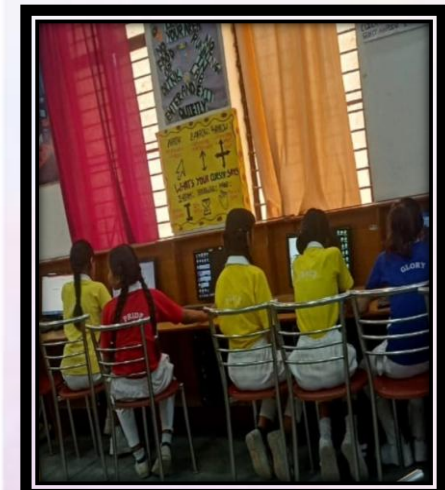

Overall, the day was well-organized and highly interactive, providing students with a balanced blend of learning and enjoyment.



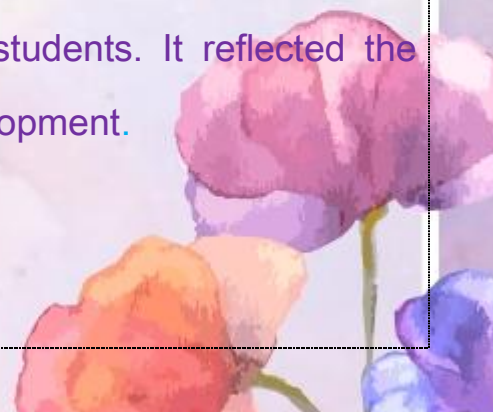


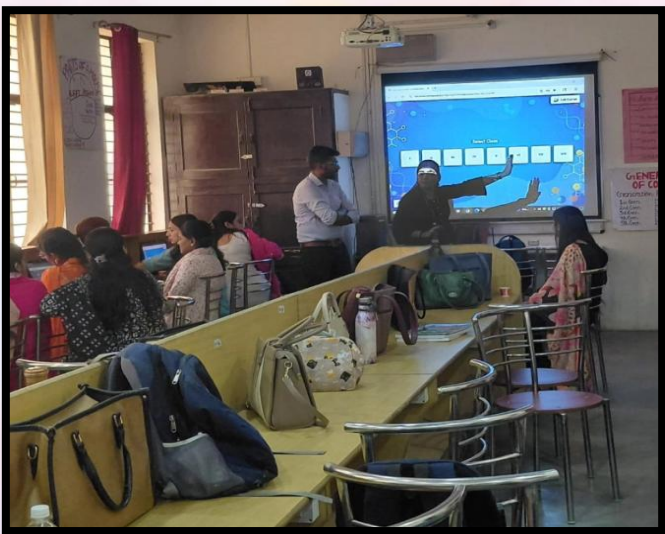
ENGLISH LAB WORKSHOP

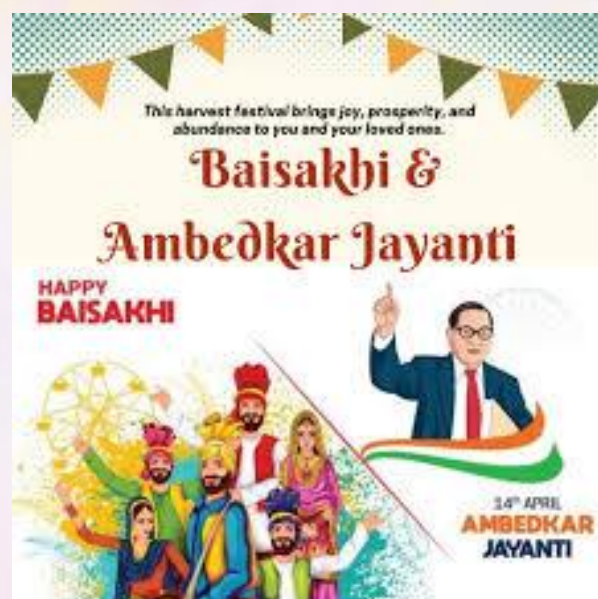
Baisakhi and Ambedkar Jayanti

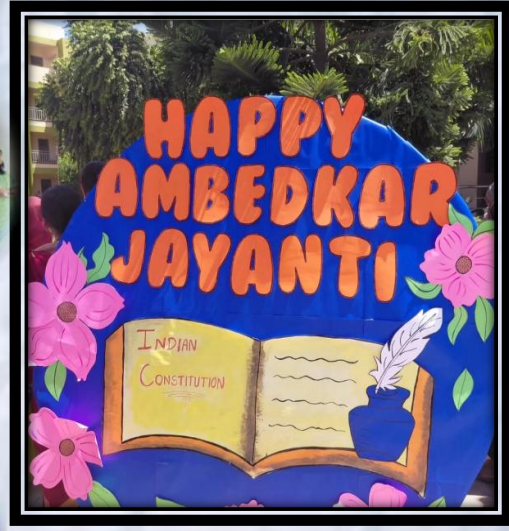

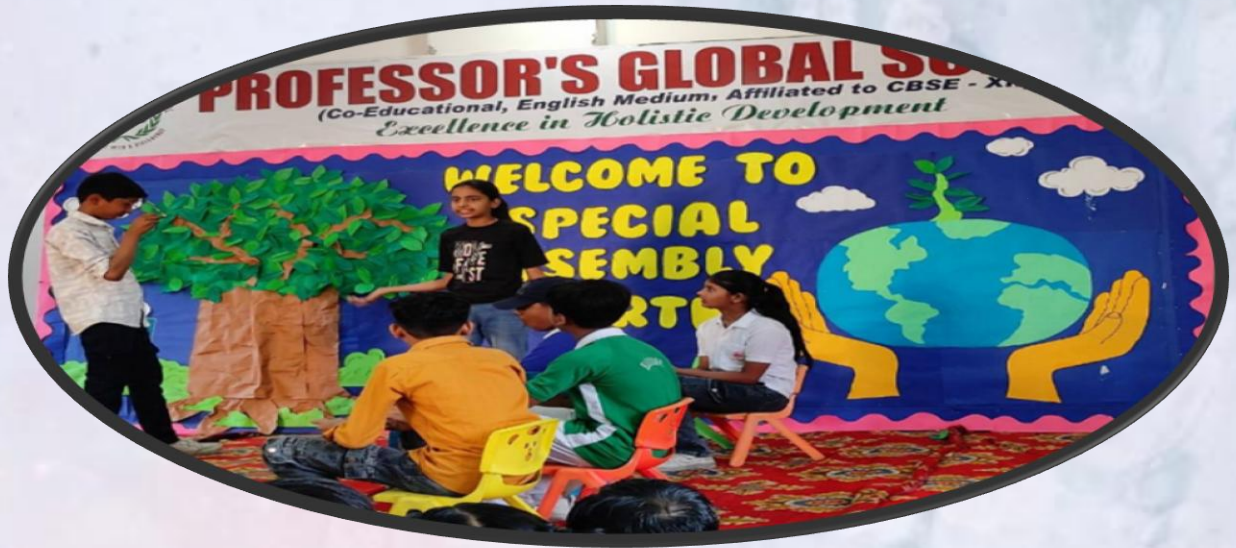
Further enriching the program, the students of Grade 3 showcased a vibrant and energetic dance performance, symbolizing harmony with nature and spreading joy among the audience.

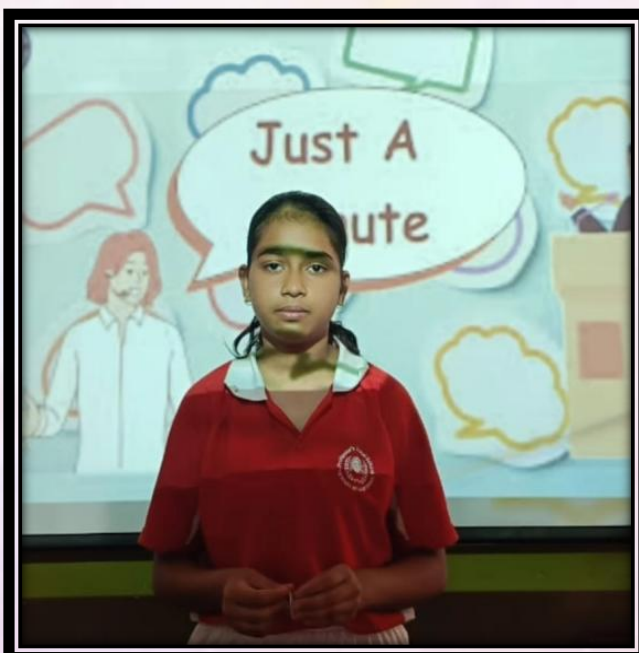
