Each effort made, each goal achieved,

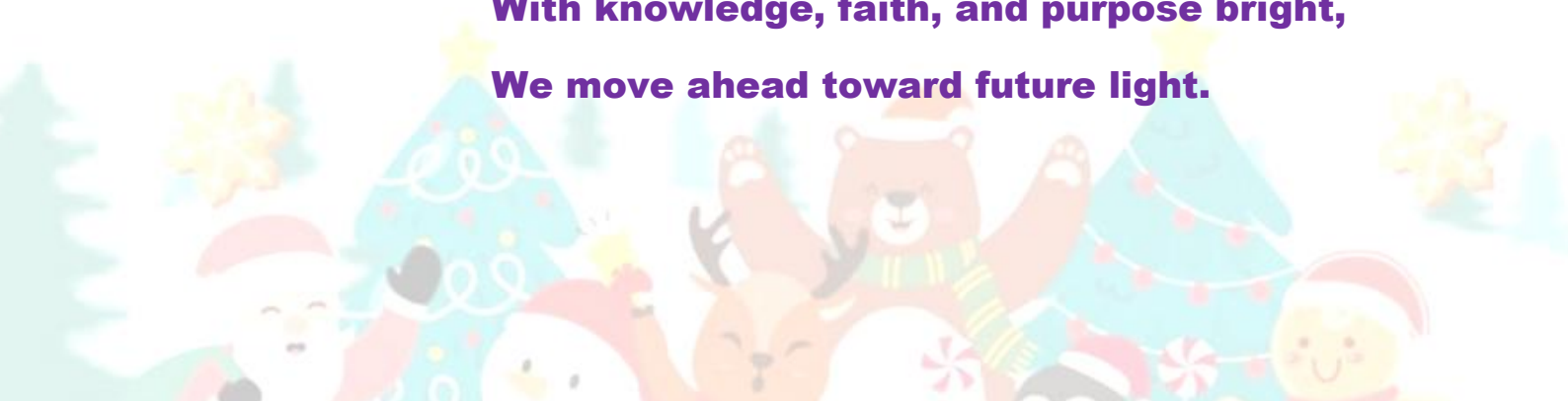



Venue: Professor's Global School





Professor's Global School organized a workshop titled "Cyber Security in the Age of AI" on 18 December for students of Grades VI to VIII. The workshop was conducted by the expert Ms. Simmi with the objective of creating awareness about cyber safety and responsible digital behaviour among students.

The session began with an interactive discussion on the apps commonly used by students and an explanation of different types of crimes, with special emphasis on cyber crimes. The expert clearly explained what cyber security is and why it is essential in today's AI-driven digital world.

Students were guided about safe and unsafe cyber activities and were informed about common cyber threats such as phishing, fake messages, and fraudulent links. The importance of using a strong password was highlighted, and students were advised not to write passwords on paper or share them with anyone.

The workshop also included an explanation of cookies in online links and how websites track user activity. Students were encouraged to think before they click on any unknown or suspicious link. They were made aware of fake URLs that look real but are unsafe, and were strictly advised never to share passwords through links or online messages.

The concept of digital footprint was explained to help students understand the long-term impact of online actions. Students were cautioned against sharing personal photos just to follow online trends. The expert encouraged students to be SMART users by being safe, mindful, alert, responsible, and thoughtful online.

The importance of cyber safety was discussed in detail, along with ways in which students can help family members stay safe online, especially elders. The session concluded with a Cybesr Safety Pledge focusing on Use, Protect, and Respect, promoting responsible digital citizenship.

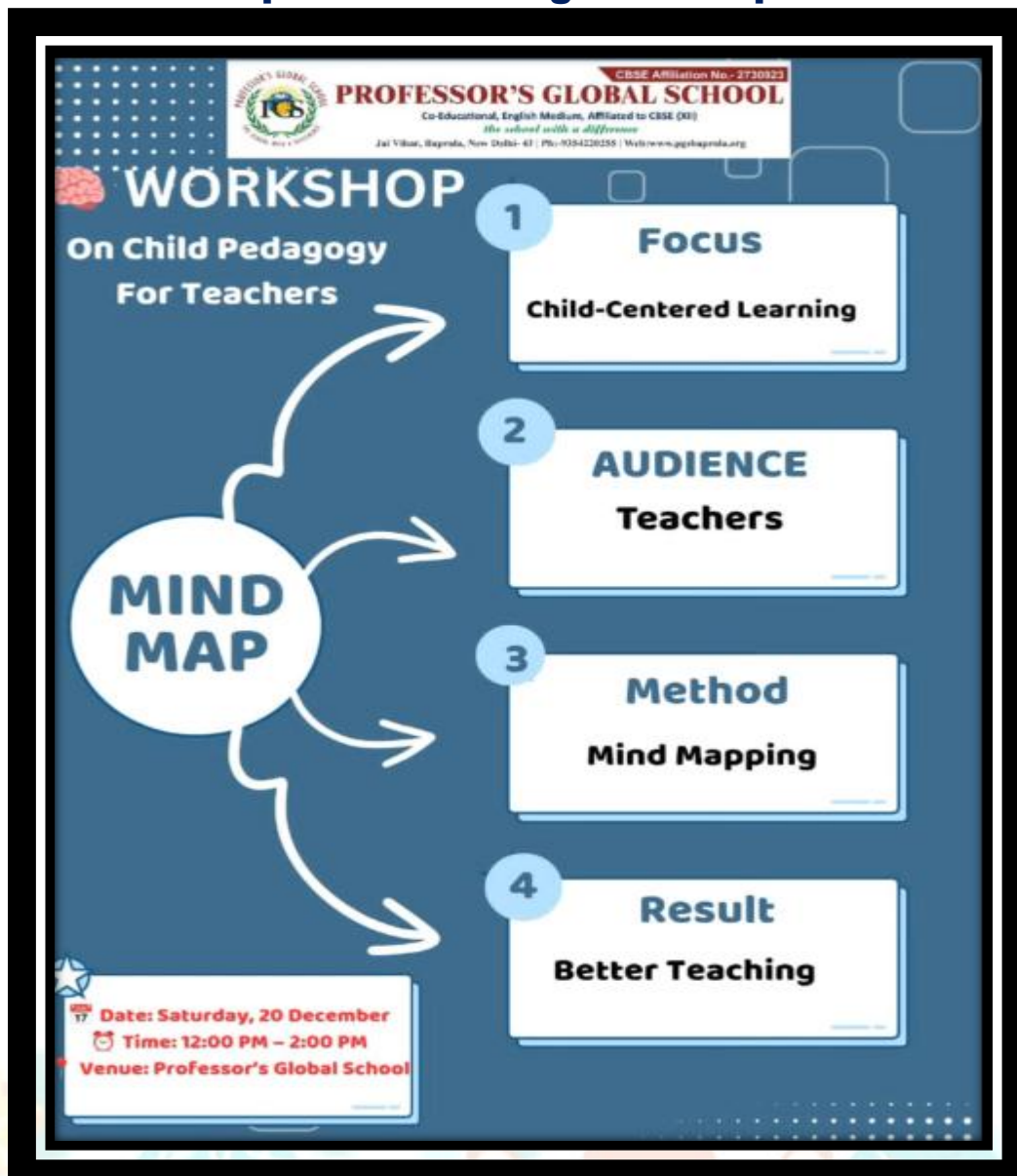
Students were also taught the reflection rule Stop, Think, Check, and Click before taking any online action. Information about the Adult Cyber Helpline number 1930 and the official reporting portal cybercrime.gov.in was shared for awareness. The workshop was informative and engaging, and it successfully enhanced students' awareness about cyber security and safe online practices in the age of AI.

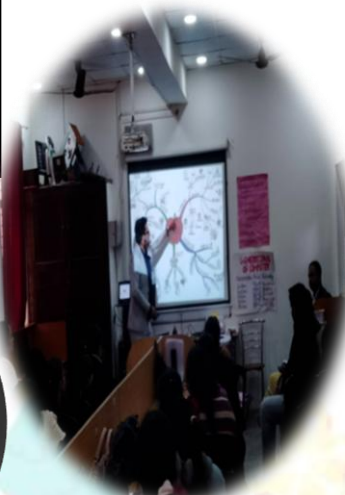

AI FOR EDUCATORS – ONLINE WEBINAR



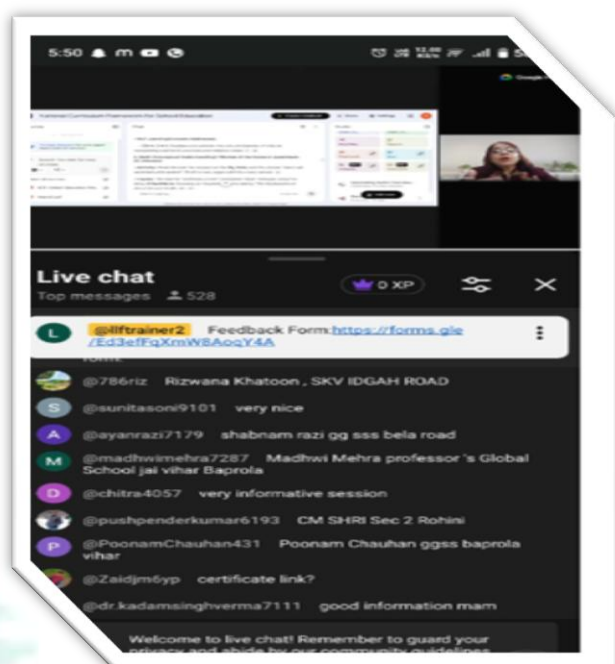
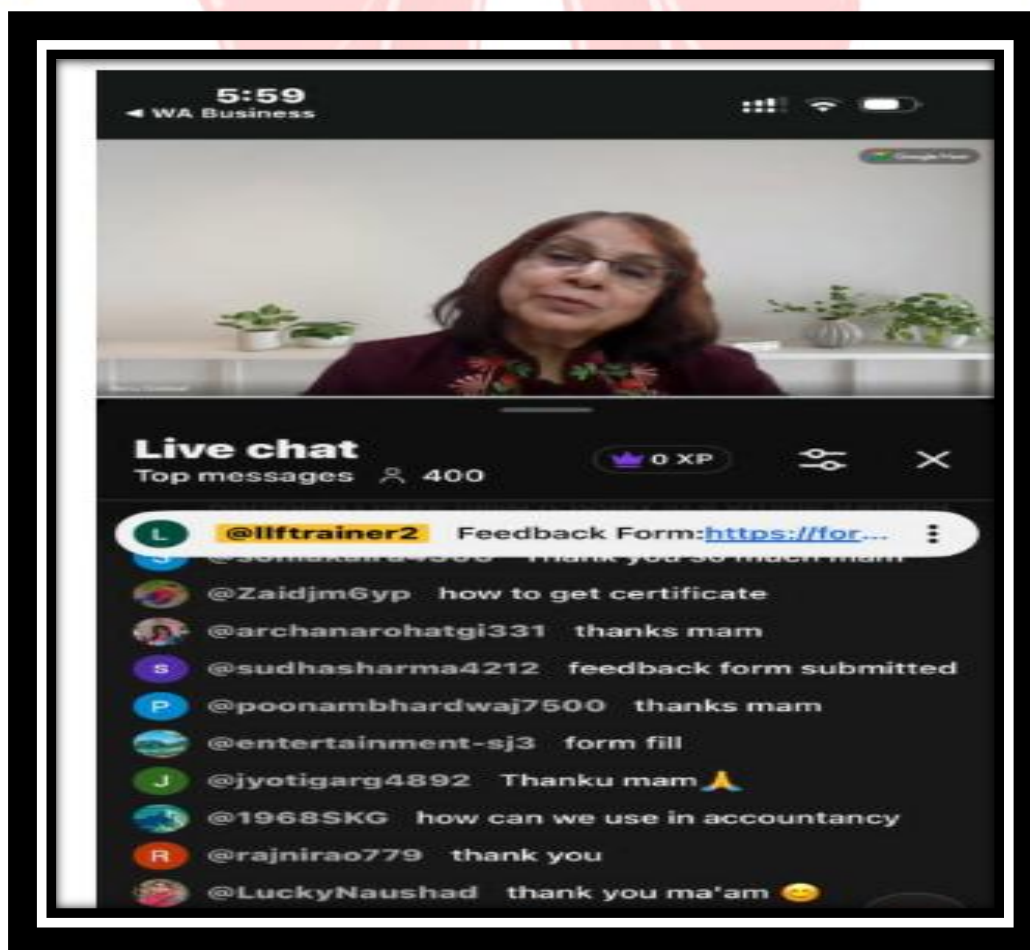

PARENT- TEACHER CONFERENCE

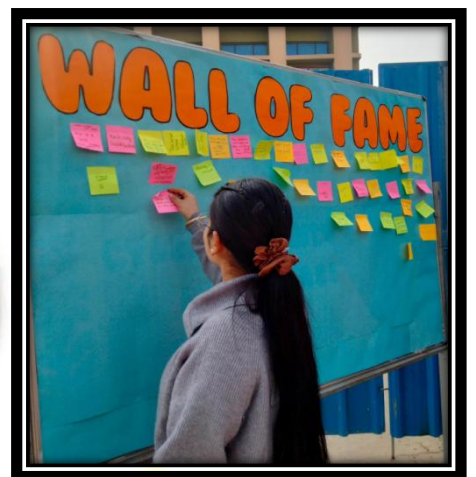

Overview: IT Club Activity – Binary Bot



The IT Club activity was well organized and highly successful. It provided students with valuable hands-on learning experience and strengthened the collaborative bond between parents, students, and the school.





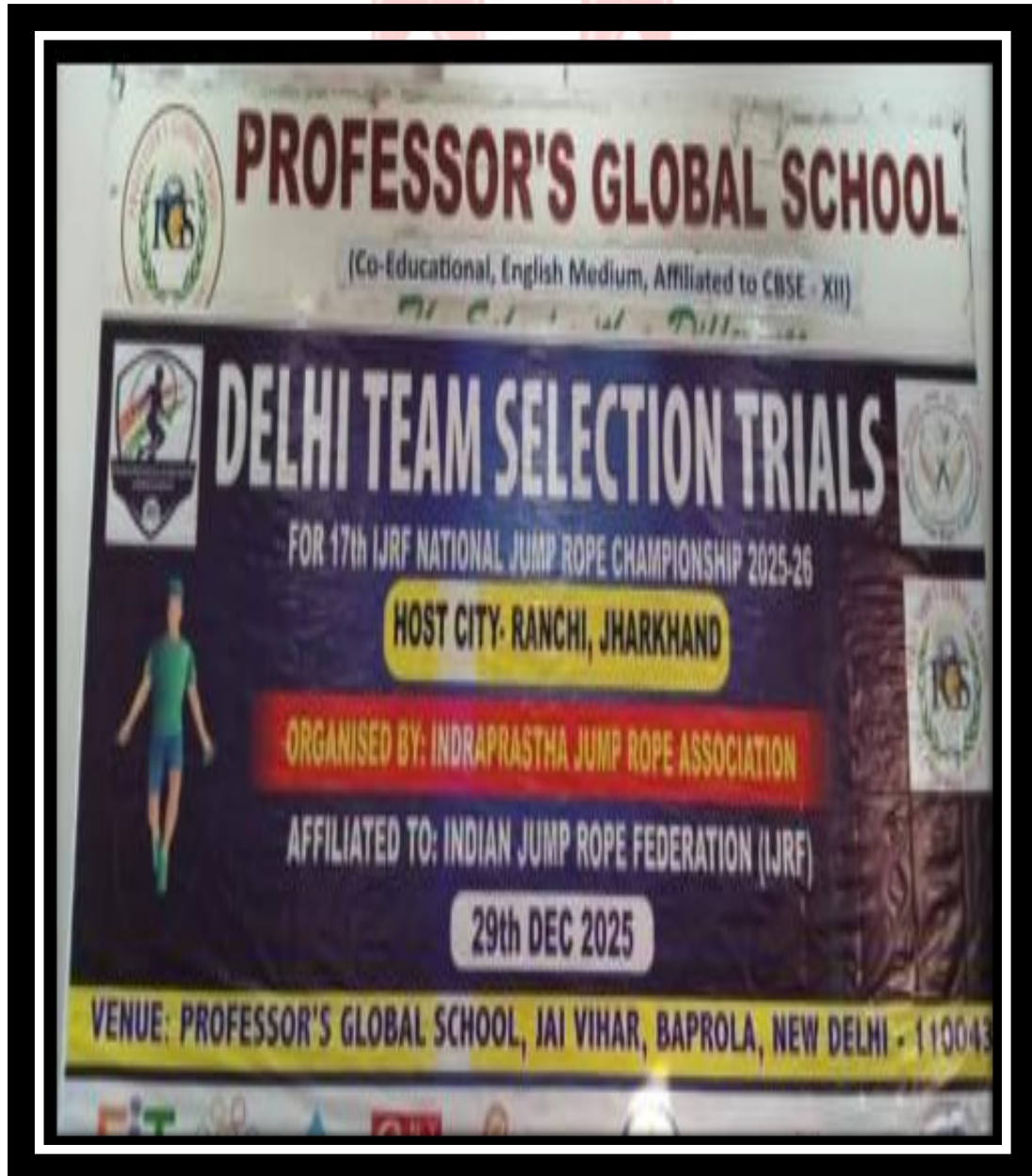


NEW EDUCATION POLICY AND ITS IMPACT ON THE EDUCATION SYSTEM

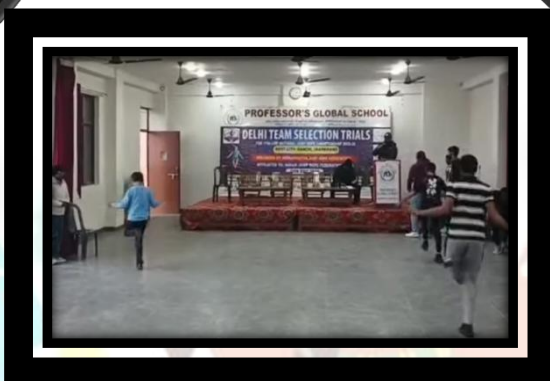


HAPPENING NOW IN OUR SCHOOL
