*TEACHERS WORKSHOP:

INTEGRATING AI WITH TEACHING*

Professor's Global School organized a one-hour workshop on July 4, 2026, to train teachers in modern educational technology. The session was led by Ms. Deepika Solanki, who demonstrated how to integrate popular AI tools like ChatGPT, Claude, and Gemini into daily teaching workflows. Teachers learned the principles of prompt engineering to efficiently generate syllabus-aligned question papers, interactive quizzes, and custom rubrics. Additionally, she explained how to use Canva step-by-step, guiding the faculty on navigating the platform to design engaging presentations, visual worksheets, and creative teaching aids.

The session featured a detailed discussion on the advantages and disadvantages of using AI in education. On the positive side, AI offers immense time efficiency in lesson planning, provides innovative ideas, and helps design highly engaging visual content through Canva. However, the resource person cautioned teachers about potential drawbacks, including the risk of factual errors (hallucinations) that require careful verification, data privacy concerns, and the danger of over-reliance, which can diminish a teacher's personal touch. The informative workshop ended with an interactive Q&A session, leaving the faculty well-equipped to use these digital tools responsibly.

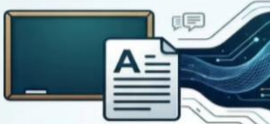

The programme continued with a series of interactive and thought-provoking activities designed to strengthen students' understanding of their rights and personal safety.

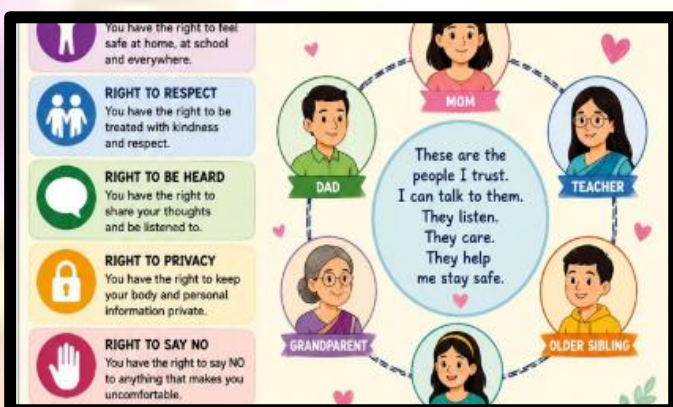

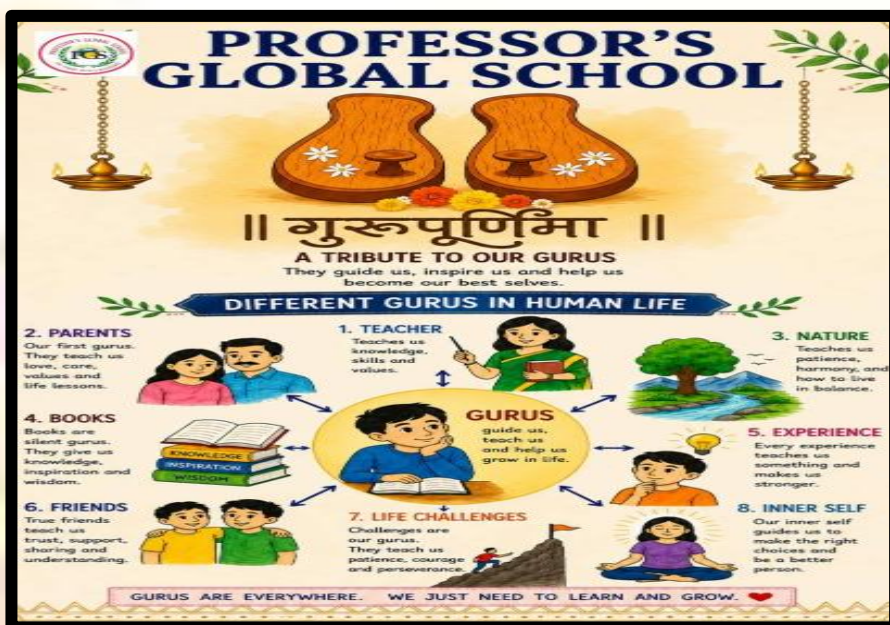
GURU PURNIMA CELEBRATION

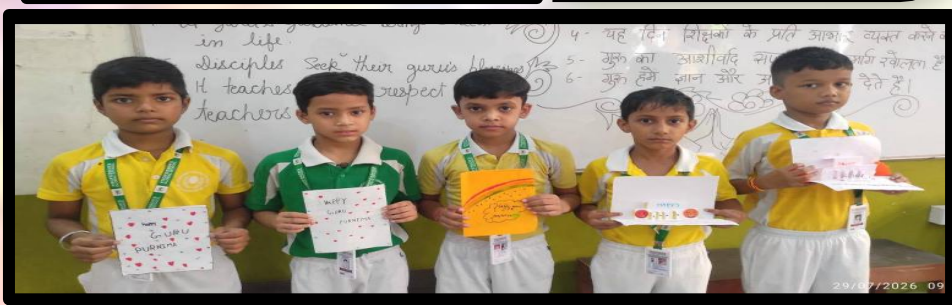
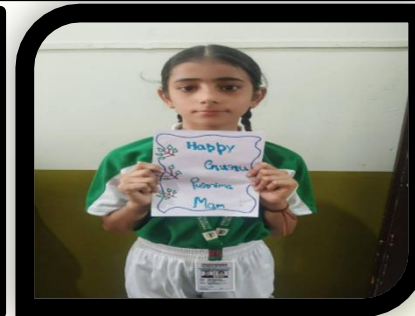
