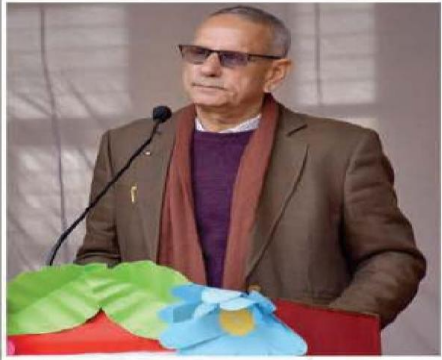

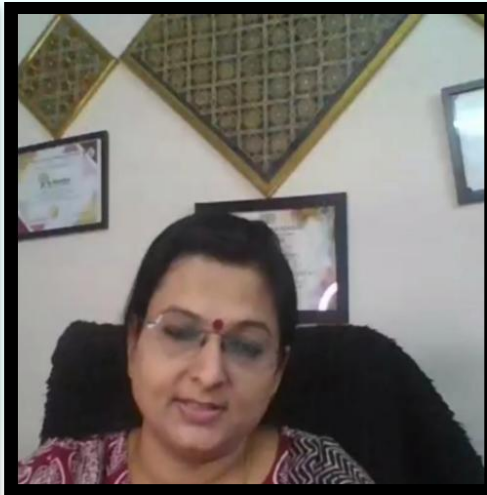
A WEBINAR ON “REIMAGINING SCIENCE CLASSROOMS

Competency, Assessment & AI in Action” was organized for the Staff of Professor’s Global School on 9 May 2026. The session was conducted by DrKshmaSwarnkar. Educators from different parts of India, including the teachers of Professor's Global School, participated enthusiastically in the webinar.

The webinar focused on transforming traditional science classrooms into competency-based and inquiry-driven learning spaces. The speaker explained the importance of active learning and highlighted the 5E Instructional Model — Engage, Explore, Explain, Elaborate, and Evaluate. It was discussed how these stages helped students develop curiosity, critical thinking, collaboration, and real-world understanding.

The session also emphasized that assessment should be a continuous process rather than only a final grading system. Different forms of assessment such as diagnostic, formative, summative, peer, self, and portfolio assessment were explained in detail. The resource person stressed that competency-based assessments should include real-life situations, higher-order thinking, data interpretation, and performance-based activities.

Another important topic discussed was the four pillars of a competency-based classroom ecosystem. These included inquiry-based learning, real-life contexts, collaborative learning, and metacognition with reflection. The speaker explained how these elements encouraged students to become active participants in the learning process. The webinar further highlighted the qualities of modern learners. Students were encouraged to develop observation and inquiry skills, problem-solving abilities, critical thinking, creativity, scientific communication, and ethical use of technology. The role of Artificial Intelligence in education was also discussed, with emphasis on using AI responsibly to enhance teaching and learning experiences. Overall, the webinar proved to be highly informative and inspiring. It provided educators with innovative ideas and practical strategies to make science teaching more engaging, meaningful, and competency-focused.

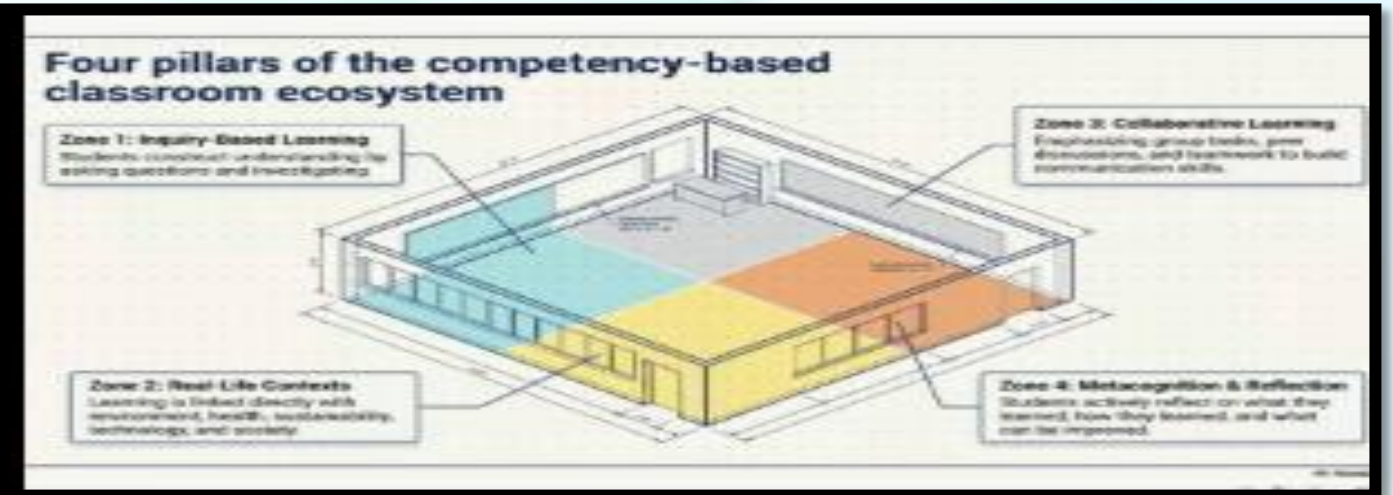
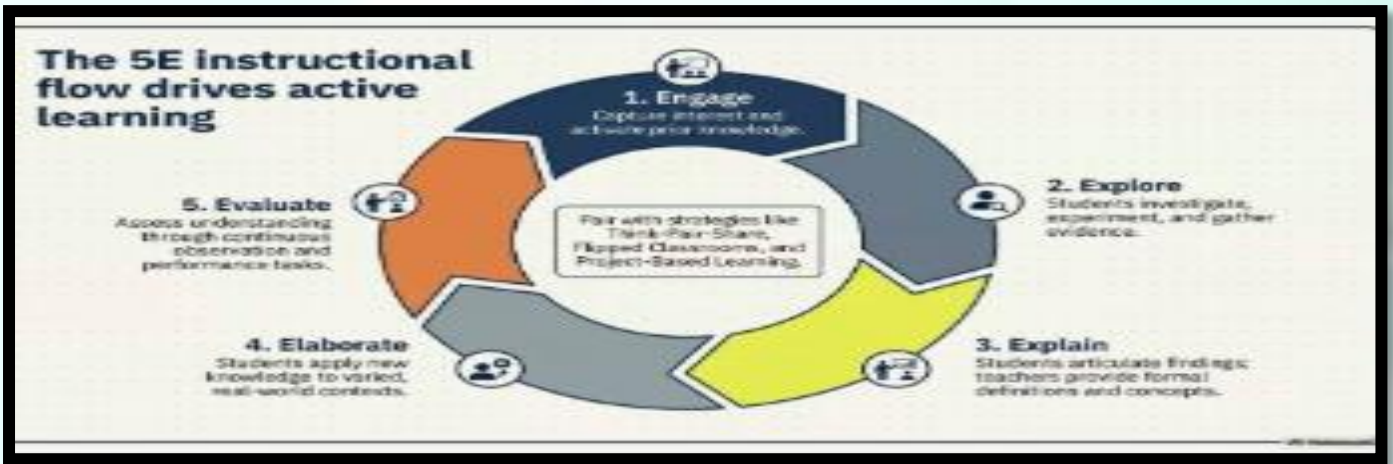

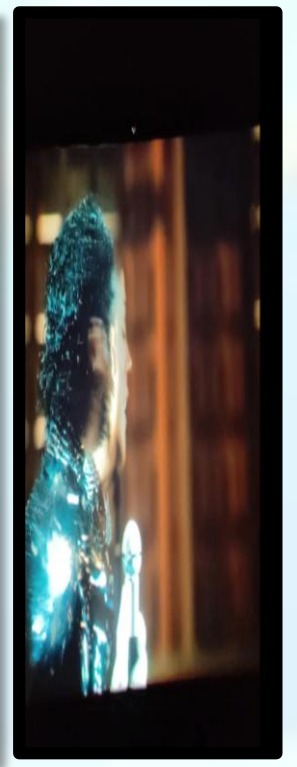


EDUCATIONAL MOVIE TRIP

A creative fingerprinting activity was organised in which students used colours and fingerprints to make beautiful designs and artwork. The activity enhanced their creativity and fine motor skills.

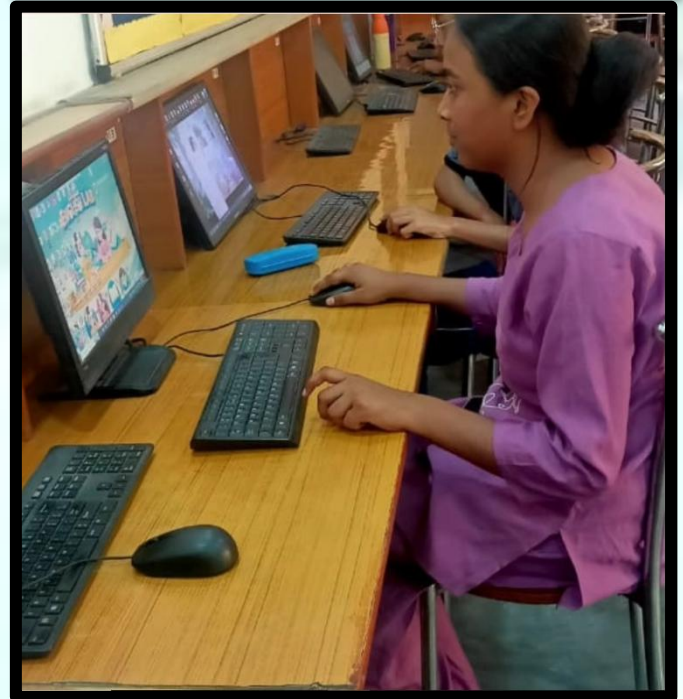
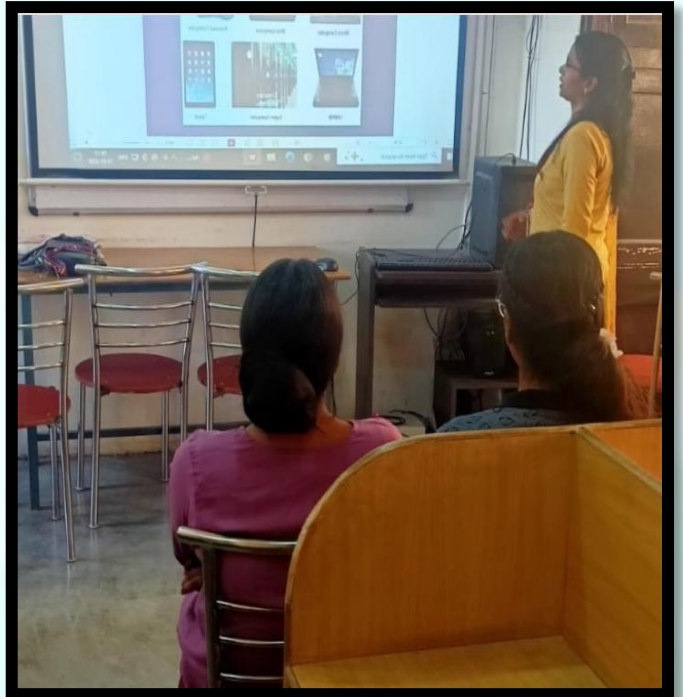
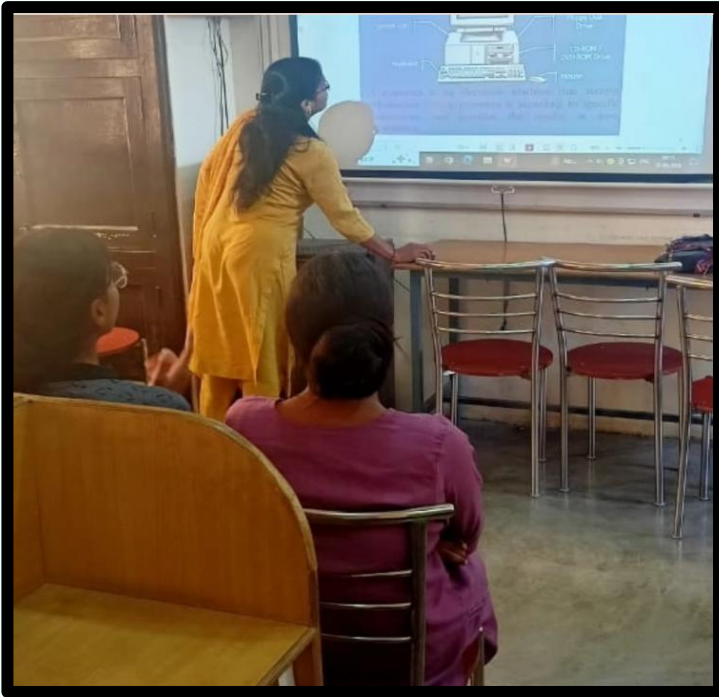
The students also enjoyed an engaging game, "Pass the Ball," which encouraged teamwork, attentiveness, and active participation.

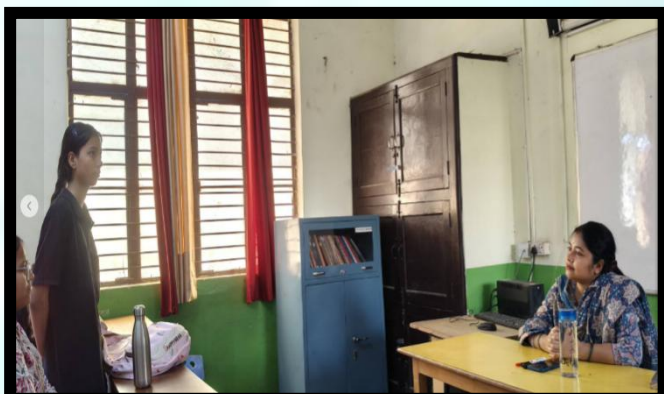

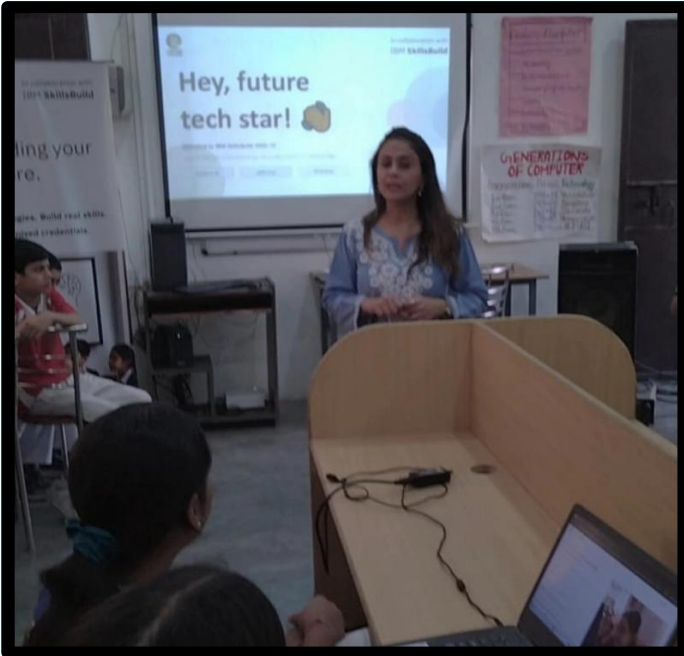
