

These activities helped students understand the value of unity, culture, teamwork, safety and national pride while learning with fun.



**Venue: Professor's Global School, Jai Vihar, Baprola, New Delhi**




# **SAFAL KSA 2025-26 ASSESSMENT**

**Professor's Global School**

**Date: November 10, 2025**

**Subject: Successful Completion of the SAFAL KSA 2025-26 Assessment (Grades 5 & 8)**

Professor's Global successfully conducted the SAFAL KSA (School Assessment for Framework & Learning Knowledge, Skills, and Attitude) assessment for students of Grade 8 and Grade 5. The digital assessments were executed in full adherence to the official examination date sheet provided by the Central Board of Secondary Education (CBSE) for the 2025-26 cycle.

The assessment cycle for Grade 8 (students currently enrolled in Grade 9) commenced in the second week of November 2025. The Language assessment was conducted on November 10 and 11, 2025, followed by the Mathematics assessment on November 12 and 13, 2025. The cycle concluded with the Science assessment, administered on November 17 and 18, 2025. The school maintained the prescribed two-day schedule for each subject and ensured sufficient technical and administrative support. Dedicated buffer days from November 19 to 21, 2025, were held in reserve to facilitate smooth logistics and timely completion of the Grade 8 cycle.

The Grade 5 assessment cycle (students currently enrolled in Grade 6) followed the Grade 8 schedule, commencing on November 24, 2025. The Language assessment was held on November 24 and 25, 2025, followed by the Mathematics assessment on November 26 and 27, 2025. The cycle concluded with the EVS (Environmental Studies) assessment, conducted on December 1 and 2, 2025. Final buffer days from December 4 to 6, 2025, marked the closure of the assessment period, confirming that all core subject examinations were successfully completed as planned.

Overall, Professor's Global successfully completed the SAFAL KSA 2025-26 assessment schedule for both Grade 5 and Grade 8 students without significant operational disruptions. Strict adherence to the official dates and efficient management of logistics ensured a fair and standardized testing environment for all participants.
